

HARRIMAN INSTITUTE PROGRAM ASSISTANT FELLOWSHIP

The Harriman Institute Program Assistant Fellowship is awarded annually to one full-time second-year graduate student pursuing a Master of Arts in Regional Studies—Russia, Eurasia, and Eastern Europe. The fellowship provides full tuition (Extended Full-Time Residence rate or the equivalent) plus a stipend.

Working with Harriman staff, Program Assistants (PAs) aid in organizing and facilitating Harriman events. PAs are expected to work 13-15 hours per week. Evening availability is required. Preference will be given to students planning to enroll for the entire academic year.
