

CLE INFORMATION

Columbia Law School has been certified by the New York State Continuing Legal Education (CLE) Board as an Accredited Provider of CLE programs. Under New York State CLE regulations, this transitional and non-transitional live CLE program will provide in aggregate a maximum of 3.5 credit hours which can be applied toward the Areas of Professional Practice requirement.

CLE credit will be awarded only to attorneys in live attendance for entire sessions, as reflected in the conference register which attorneys must sign both prior to and following their attending program sessions. Attorneys attending only part of a session are not eligible for partial credit for it. Attorneys arriving late are welcome to attend a program session in progress but will not be eligible for CLE credit for that session; similarly, attorneys leaving a session early are ineligible for CLE credit for that session. On departure, attorneys seeking credit should also submit their completed Evaluation Form, provided at the Conference.
